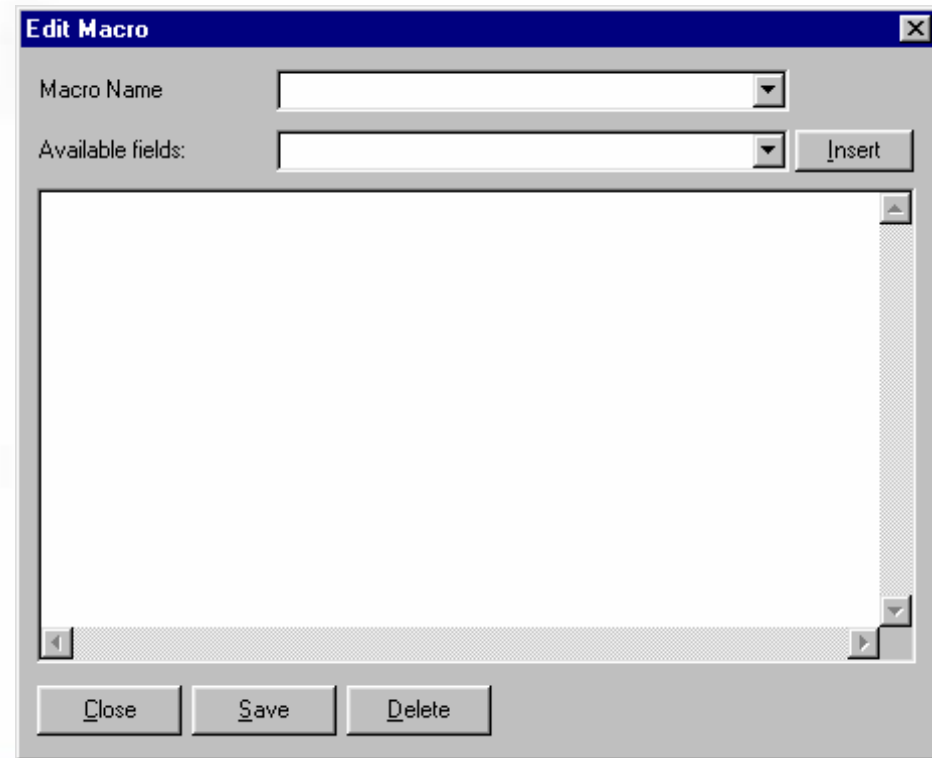

## What is a Macro?

- A macro is a small program
- Are embedded in the Visual executables.
- Only available on Visual 6.2 and up
- Used to automate certain tasks
- Naming convention : APPLICATION\_MACRONAME.VMS

## Where can macros be run?

- Customer Order Entry
- Order Management Window
- Return Material Authorization
- Purchase Order Entry
- Purchase Receipt Entry
- Manufacturing Window
- Part Maintenance



## How to create a macro.

- **The macro language is VBScript.**
- **All applications will only see macros that begin with their base name.**
  - Order Entry will only see macros beginning with VMORDENT\_OnSave.

SHIP_VIA = "FEDEX"
